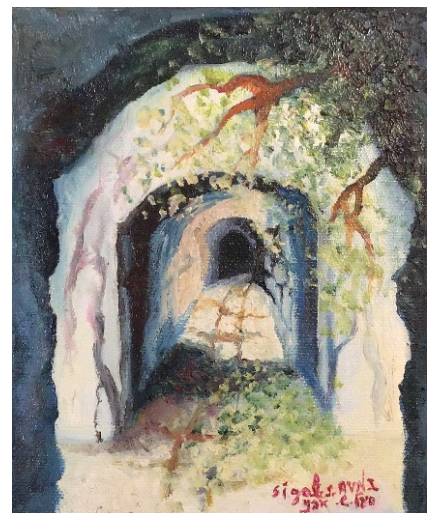
The door swings both ways
